

### How to pray for the Persecuted Christians in North Korea

(summary of an article in Open Doors magazine Jan 2017)

The World Watch List 2017 has been published, based on information gathered throughout 2016. North Korea remains the country where Christians experience the worst persecution for the 16<sup>th</sup> consecutive year.

Leader: Supreme Leader Kim Jong Un

**Population:** 25,405,000 (300,000 Christians) **Main Religion:** Atheism/traditional beliefs

**Government:** Dictatorial paranoia

Source of Persecution: Communist Oppression, Dictatorial Paranoia.

The family that has ruled North Korea for three generations are worshipped like gods, and any suggestion that there is a higher authority than the nation's leader, Kim Jong-Un, is immediately crushed. Tens of thousands of Christians are incarcerated in horrific labour camps, and thousands more are forced to hide their faith completely from government authorities, neighbours and often, even their own spouses and children. Due to ever-present surveillance, many pray with their eyes open, and gathering for praise or fellowship is practically impossible.

Brother Andrew, founder of Open Doors, says, "Our prayers can go where we cannot.

There are no borders, no prison walls, no doors that are closed to us when we pray."

He has suggested some ideas to prompt us to pray for the church in North Korea in the coming weeks.



### 1 Pray when you eat

**Pray** that God will bless North Korean Christians as they share the little food they have, with others.

### 2 Pray when you open your Bible

The Bible is a forbidden book but there is probably no other country in the world with so many hidden Bibles. Some are literally buried in the ground and dug up to read.

**Pray** that North Korean Christians will be brave enough to own a Bible and for their protection as they read it in secret.

**Pray** that God will enable Open Doors workers to smuggle more Bibles to North Korean believers.

### 3 Pray as you walk down the street

North Korean Christians know that they are always being watched by their neighbours.

**Pray** that God will make their seeing eyes, blind, and that the North Korean Christians will not be discovered.

### 4 Pray when you hear a siren

Tens of thousands of North Korean Christians are imprisoned in prison camps or sentenced to forced labour.

**Pray** for their strength, comfort, and that they will soon be free. **Pray** especially that those who have started to lose hope, or even given up on their faith, will know God's love and presence with them.









For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands.
